ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF VISITING BROTHERS: Brother Ricky Lewis, 1st Vice Grand Basileus Brother 1st Vice was welcomed by Bro. Broughton on behalf of Omicron Mu and greeted the Body. Bro. Lewis proceed to provide the following report on the fraternity's status and outlook...

- The Fraternity is Financially Solvent and secure
- Fraternity is donating \$500K for HBCUs
- Upcoming Conclaves: 2023 Nassau, 2024 Tampa
- The Divine 9 was provided a Grant for \$2.7M to promote Covid Awareness within our communities
- St Judes relationship remains strong, notes that 40% of the children treated at St. Judes are African-American
- SEC issues persist as these are an essential part in regulating events where the Frat could be held liable. Issue is generally
 under control leading to reduced insurance premiums.
- 501C4 Status allows the Fraternity to donate towards political causes unlike the 501C3. Plans are to remain active and provide support to issues and representatives that uphold the fraternity's interest values
- Bro. Lewis is actively campaigning for the office of Grand Basileus... His platform is based on *Retention *Fratherhood Initiative *Protect Our Brand *Solicitation of High Profile/Character Brothers coming back or joining the fold *Note: 70% of new Brothers disappear after 3 years.
- Chapter MSP Programs Chapter must be approved to hase an MSP Program, ONLY Trained Bros. can participate
